# More than 100,000 visitors to Epizen after the arrival of Family Cash

# Arrested for disobeying the Police and carrying multiple forged identity documents

A 31-year-old man, non-resident, was arrested on Monday at 10.50 a.m., in Pas de la Casa, as the alleged perpetrator of several crimes, including the falsification of documents, disobedience to aut-

hority and impersonation identity.

The events were triggered during a routine prevention round in the parish, when the agents tried to identify the individual. Instead of cooperating, the man chose to run away, which led to a short chase through the stre-

ets of Pas de la Casa. Once arrested, several identity documents bearing his name were found. According to police sources, once at the police station, his fingerprints revealed that he had previously been controlled by the Police and that he had provided a false identity.

The detainee is now facing charges for crimes against public service, disobedience and against security in legal traffic. ●
