The resident population increased by 4.3% and now exceeds 84,500 people

Growth is concentrated in Andorra la Vella, Encamp, Canillo, Escaldes-Engordany and La Massana

he resident population in the Principality until October amounts to 84,516 people, which represents an increase of 4.3%, 3,459 more people than in October 2022. As can be seen in the data published by the Department of Statistics last Monday, this growth is mainly concentrated in the parishes of Andorra la Vella (3.3%), Encamp (5.2%), Canillo (12.4%), Escaldes-Engordany (3.7%) and La Massana (4.3%). The parishes that have grown least in the last year have been Ordino (4%) and Sant Julià de Lòria (2%). In the month of October 2023, the estimated deviation in relation to the same month in 2022 has increased in the parishes of Ordino (0.7%), La Massana (0.3%) and Sant Julià de Lòria (0.2%), while it remains stable in Andorra la Vella (0.0%) and decreases in Canillo (2.2%), Escaldes-Engordany (0.3%) and Encamp

By nationality, the annual increase measured in October is concentrated in the group of other nationalities with a total of 2,871 people (29.3%), followed by people of

Spanish nationality, with 358 people (1.8%); of those of French nationality, with 175 people (4.8%), and of Andorran nationality, with 162 people (0.4%). People with Portuguese nationality registered a decrease of 107 people (1.2%) compared to the same month of the previous year.

73.1% of the population, moreover, is concentrated between the ages of 15 and 64, and the population under 15 represents 11.8%, while the population over 64 represents the remaining 15.1%.

Regarding the data of the population registered in the municipal censuses as of October 31st (89,787 people), there is an increase of 4.2% compared to the population registered in the same month of 2022 (86,174 people).

Since December 2009, the Department of Statistics has estimated the resident population in the Principality on a monthly basis based on communal censuses and cross-checking with other available administrative records. Otherwise, the Principality of Andorra has communal registers through which the registered population figure derived from additions and subtractions in the different municipalities obtained directly.

It should be noted that the population data registered in the municipalities is in the process of continuous review, given that since March 2012 the Government established a monthly exchange of information with the municipalities so that they can update their census data. For this reason, the variations in the registered population data are motivated, among others, by administrative purges.

At the same time, Statistics point out that it must be taken into

account that the population estimates do not include a validation process for residents with Andorran nationality as complete as that which can be applied to the case of residents of other nationalities. ≡

The number of visitors increased by 6.1%

A total of 692,368 visitors entered the country in October, of which 44,341 were hikers (64.2%) and 247,927 were tourists (35.8%). The number of visitors has increased by 6.1%, compared to the month of October last year; tourists have increased by 4.2%, while hikers have presented an increase of 7.2%. In the last 12 months, visitors have increased by 13.5% in relation to the same period of the previous year. By nationality, visitors from other origins have risen by 27.1%, followed by Spanish and French visitors, who have shown increases of 14.9% and 8.1% respectively. \equiv

In the month of October, 358,214 vehicles entered the Principality, which represents a positive percentage change compared to October of the previous year of 5.9%. The total of passenger cars has shown an increase of 5.1% and that of heavy vehicles by 38.6%. For their part, passenger cars from Spain have had a positive variation of 6.8%, while for those from France, there has been a percentage variation of 1.9%. Regarding heavy vehicles, there was a positive percentage change of 39.1% for the Spanish-Andorran border, and 33.8% for the Franco-Andorran border.≡

he junior consul, Quim Dolsa, and the Minister of Cultural Life, Valentí Closa, presented on Monday morning the activities that will take place in the parish of Escaldes-Engordany this Christmas. And the fact is that the parish enters, from 6.00 p.m. this Friday, November 24th, a 'Fantastical Christmas' in which different actions will take place, among them, the living nativity scene, the Flavors of Advent, and the lighting of Christmas lights that will mark the beginning of this festive cycle. This year the lighting will be carried out by the neighboring parish, Andorra la Vella, and will start at 18.00 on De la Unió street. Then, on the Escalde side, as was done last year, there will be a show that will start in De la Unió street and end in Coprínceps square. The councilor explained that it will be the same show that was already held, in which there will be musical accompaniment that will accompany the attendees to the square, where an a cappella carol will be sung, around 6:15 p.m., while hot chocolate and ginger cookies will be offered to all those who want to share this Christmas exit in Escaldes-Engordany.

The Minister of Cultural Life stated that they are «very happy» with the return of the living nativity scene, during the 22nd and 23rd of December in the Prat de Roure room, which after a four-year hiatus returns with an innovative format and more immersive that includes audiovisual. This year, it has decided to represent a nativity scene that will recover some of the most iconic scenes from its history. Tickets must be purchased through the Municipality website at a price of 3 euros.

Another of the strong points of this Christmas will be the proposal of Flavors of Advent which will be held in Parc de la Mola. There will be a Christmas village with five booths, three food trucks, 14 artisans, four restaurateurs and a who-
