Concòrdia and PS name the budget framework very optimistic

he two amendments presented before yesterday by the Social Democratic and Concòrdia parliamentary groups to the budget framework for the 2024-2027 mandate were rejected with a result for both votes with 19 votes against, seven in favor and no abstentions. The opposition parliamentary groups explained during the debate at the General Council session that the proposed budget framework lacks predictability regarding the possible changes that may occur in the years in which the budget framework is in force, since the forecasts contemplates this are considered by the Social Democratic and Concòrdia parliamentary groups as too optimistic. The argument of the opposition, embodied by the social democrat Susanna Vela and the leader of Concòrdia, Cerni Escalé, is based on the fact that they believe that the analyzed figures rely too

much on the post-covid dynamics that have been followed so far, where the growth of the Andorran economy has been accelerated by the abandonment of the lockdown measures against Covid-19, an exponential growth of the construction sector and the same touristic economic model that is conducive to time to recover the rate of economic growth after a crisis that prevents the entry of tourists into the country, among others. The Minister of Finance, Ramón Lladós, defended that the budget framework has been drawn up and designed according to the data provided by the Department of Government Statistics, which were considered by the minister himself to be highly rigorous and prudent, in addition to endorse the favorable and more optimistic opinions of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) regarding the growth of the Andorran economy.

VELA WARNS ABOUT THE OPTIMISTIC VISI-ON OF THE GOVERNMENT// The general councilor of the PS, Susanna Vela, stated when defending the amendment that «it cannot be that a country like ours, which depends on tourism, and especially on proximity, double the Spanish GDP and even quadruple the French», criticizing the optimistic perspectives with which the PS accuses the

Government of having drawn up the budget framework. The social democratic councilor expressed the concern of her parliamentary group towards «that the GDP increases much more than our neighboring countries due to local tourism and rampant construction». Likewise, Vela also denounced the progressive indebtedness of the State declaring that «when before, for every 100 euros that the Government brought in, 80 was spent, now of these 100 euros, it spends 90 and only 10 are left. In other words, he owes more money every year, but spends more money".

Bartolomé doubts the CDI drafting system

The General Council session also debated and ratified the **Non-Double Taxation Conventi**on (CDI) with Iceland. The Councilor of Concòrdia, Pol Bartolomé, asked about the strategy followed by the Government to sign these agreements, accusing that «the State has lost its strategic, reflexive and pragmatic component». Minister Lladós and the councilor of the majority, Berna Coma, clarified that these agreements are drawn up rigorously and based on the available capacities.

HT»∥ The leader of Concòrdia, Cerni Escalé, defended the amendment of his parliamentary group claiming that it has a short-term perspective. Escalé warned about the fact that the State has a debt of between 1,310 and 1,110 million euros, mentioning that the revenues with which the Government can currently count do not cover public expenses, in addition to warning of that the budgetary framework maintains deficit forecasts in the next four years. The leader of Concòrdia declared that «if we now began to prematurely repay the debts contracted, the new debt that we would have to assume as a State in the event of an economic crisis, would probably be at a higher rate due to the current state of the markets».





The Police participate in a cybercrime conference

The appointment took place between the 13th and 15th of this December in Bucharest

The Police Technology Crime Group was present at the Council of Europe (CoE) Octopus conference, represented by an officer as Deputy Expert of the Cybercrime Convention Committee and National Representative of the 24/7 Network Point of Contact of the Budapest Convention. The conference was held between 13th and 15th December in the city of Bucharest, Romania, at the headquarters of the Council of Europe Cybercrime Program Office (C-PROC). The congress brought together more than 500 specialists in technological crimes from more than 100 countries with the aim of strengthening international cooperation to combat cybercrime. Police forces, prosecutors, international organizations, the private sector and the academic world took part in it. The summit was one of the largest platforms for the exchange of knowledge and experience, where crucial topics such as cybercrime legislation, cyber security, the use of artificial intelligence (AI) in this type of crimes, online child sebullying. At the same time, there was also discussion about freedom of expression, disinformation, manipulation and digital authoritarianism, spoofing, the convergence between physical and digital evidence, as well as strategies to fight malware, ransomware and the illicit actions committed through the use of cryptocurrencies to try not to leave a trace. From the National Police Force, the fight against cybercrime is considered a key issue that knows no borders, and for this reason it is considered crucial to attend international assemblies of this level, in which cooperation tools and the best practices for dealing with these crimes, in order to strengthen the capacity to act with effective responses with the aim of guaranteeing human rights and legality.

It should be remembered that the Budapest Convention was created in 2001, and entered into force in 2004. It is the first international treaty created with the aim of protecting society from cybercrime and promoting cooperation between countries and to share information more quickly. Andorra signed it in 2016. \equiv
