ast weekend the twentieth edition of the Medieval Village was celebrated in the parish of Sant Julià de Lòria. One of the most attractive examples for both Lauredians and tourists has been a Ferris wheel that was in La Germandat square, right in the middle of the town, together with a carousel. 



Dr. Michel Rogé opens the door to the first congress of dentists


